This Fall 2014, First Presbyterian Church of Newhall invites busy adults in the SCV community to a new series of courses through its "Life Academy." Do you want to continue learning? Is it hard to fit traditional classes into your busy lifestyle? Life Academy is designed to fit into your cramped schedule and busy lifestyle by offering short courses, which are only one to six one-hour sessions in length.

Fall 2014 Life Academy has many courses on a variety of subjects, including a movie night *and* an informal gathering each Sunday – choose one or more that fits your own interests and needs.

Life Academy courses are offered at a variety of times to fit your busy schedule. Most classes are one hour in length; the informal gathering is 30 minutes.

Life Academy courses are taught by experts in each of the topics: pastors, nutritionist, and Biblical students. You will benefit from their knowledge.
