It draws on the way Jews read the Haggadah, a text read during Passover that retells the Exodus story. Haggadad means 'telling' and along with being a physical text, the word captures the practice of telling and retelling a story. The Christian form of Lectio Divina was first introduced by St Gregory of Nyssa (c 330-395)...When we practice Lectio Divina, we can imagine we're actually involved in the events of Scripture..."-Elizabeth Manneh
